Jason -

I run IDL 5.0.2 on a PB 3400c/240 with 144 Mbyte of memory (we show long, large-format movies using CW_ANIMATE) and have run into no problems so far.

The only "problem" I have run into is the ^%\$& dongle hanging off the ADB port, which is (+) on the side, rather than the back of the PB 3400, but which (-) requires you to open a little door to access it.

If you'd like to run some sample code, give me a call.
