I use IDL 5.0.2 and ENVI 2.7 on my PowerBook 5300ce and PowerMac 7500 every day running MacOS 8 with no problems at all. Be sure you have at least 32 MB RAM on the system. It works fine with 32 MB, but that's the bare minimum as far as I'm concerned.
