The problem I am facing is the following:

I use `create_view` to generate a 3D coordinate system.
Then I draw some curves using the `plots` procedure.

How do I place text at position (x,y,z) (in data coordinates)?
Is there any 3D analog of the `xyouts` procedure?
I'd like to label some of these curves etc.

And how can I draw an arrow from (x_1,y_1,z_1) to (x_2,y_2,z_2) ?
I can assemble it myself from three line segments, but given that there is an arrow intrinsic for 2D, I am wondering if there is something equivalent for 3D.
