PV-Wave allows unnamed (i.e., anonymous) structures as well.

However, the syntax is just slightly different, requiring a comma \*at the start\* of the definition, to show that the name is missing:

```
IDL> struct = { A:0, B:0.0 }
```

```
PV-WAVE> struct = { , A:0, B:0.0 }
```
