- > Isn't [the Student Version of IDL] constrained to 65000
- > array elements? (I mean: total, not for one dimension)

The Student Version of IDL is constrained to arrays of no larger than 65000 elements (256 x 256). Other limitations include no SAVE files and no linking to other programs (e.g. Call_External, et. al.). Other than that, all the normal IDL things are available, including widgets.

It is also my understanding that this version is sold *only* to students.
