> Just for the records: there is another way of doing it

Use XTICKFORMAT='NOLABEL'

and keep the function NOLABEL somewhere:

- > function NOLABEL, axis, index, value
- > ; function for the graphics keyword tickformat
- > ; returns an empty string for no tick annotation
- return, "
- > end

This is a method I should have thought of myself. :-)

But what I've always done (and I am ashamed to say I don't even *really* know why it works) is this:

Plot, data, XTickformat='(A1)'

Nuts, now I'm going to have to think up a new question for admission into the IDL Expert Programmers Association. :-(
