The answer is, you are printing the first character of whatever STRING makes of your numerical tick value. In most cases that will be a space. To get the idea of what happens, compare

```
print, format='(a)', 1.
and
print, format='(a1)', 1.
```

I tried to find an example where your method fails, but that is not as easy as I thought - perhaps impossible.
