Roger Zimmermann writes:

- > How can we plot one headline/title in a multplot
- > window (36 boxes) w/ Direct Graphics?

Normally when you set up a multiplot window:

!P.Multi = [0, 6, 6]

IDL calculates the size of the plots based on the entire window. What you want to do is save some room at the top for a title for the entire window. You do this with the !Y.OMargin (Y Outside Margin) system variable. Margins, you recall, are set in *character* units, so this code is not completely machine portable (you have to experiment a little), but I have had success with something like this:

!Y.OMargin = [2, 4] !P.Multi = [0, 6, 6] For j=0,35 DO Plotting(j) XYOutS, 0.5, 0.9, /Normal, 'Plot Title', Size=2, Align=0.5
