> different gamma correction to each image.  
> Something like ...  
>     LOADCT, 3  
>  
>     TV, image1  
>     GAMMA\_CT,.7  
>  
>     TV, image2  
>     GAMMA\_CT,.3  
>  
> The GAMMA\_CT changes the appearance of both the images each time  
> it is applied - I want a separate gamma correction for each image.

How about something like this:

```
SET_PLOT,'PS'  
DEVICE,/COLOR,BITS=8
```

```
LOADCT, 3  
GAMMA_CT,.7  
TV, image1
```

```
LOADCT, 3  
GAMMA_CT,.3  
TV, image2
```

```
DEVICE,/CLOSE
```
