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I'm running IDL 4.x remotely on a Sun using an xterm emulator on my Win 95 machine. IDL and my xterm emulator both agree on my screen size (currently 800 x 600). Is it possible for me to use IDL to display a 800 x 600 image array so that it will fill up the entire screen, without showing any window borders etc.? When I use the WINDOW command, the window is off center and I have the title bar and window borders to contend with. Can I get rid of the bar and the borders for any size image?

In other words, if I want to be able to paint the (m,n)-th pixel on my display red, can I use IDL to do it?
