> title or heading. I can't remember the variable, though. I'm using
> !p.multi, but want to leave room at the top of the page for a title

> accomplish this task.

You can use the system variable !Y.OMargin (outside margin)
to leave room for a title when using !P.Multi. This and other
tips about PostScript output can be found on my web page.
