Andy Standley wrote:

> I use pvwave to create plots etc for satellite images. Sometimes I need
> to process many images and produce the same style of plot many times
> just changing the input filename and annotation strings. Is there a way
> to call pvwave with command-like args i.e.
>
> wave run_my_prog name1 title1
> wave run_my_prog name2 title2
```

I don't think so. 'wave run_my_prog' is equivalent to '@run_my_prog' at the pvwave prompt, but I don't believe there is a way to get the other parameters.

A workaround would be to build a script which puts the arguments in some file and then calls wave, and then the inputs are read from there. I always wanted to write something like this, but I just haven't had the time yet.
