I guess I wasn't clear enough. What seems to be the most interesting question here is whether the Un*x implementation of IDL is as good as the NT implementation. The best way to do that is to compare the benchmark numbers from >> the same hardware << running equivalent versions of the NT and Linux implementation. I don't have easy net access for a few weeks, but I believe RSI has a Linux/Intel implementation, and of course they have an NT/Intel implementation. If they have both Linux/Alpha and NT/Alpha implementations, that would be another interesting comparison.
