Hi,

I'm trying to view a 3-D image in two different windows of two different sizes. I would like the image to look approximately the same in both windows. The problem is that the two windows are different sizes (specifically 608x486 and 576x792). Obviously when I plot the data using SURFACE the results are quite different in each window. I've been trying to fool around with the POSITION key word to scale the plot so that it looks the same in both windows, but I haven't come up with any satisfactory results. Does anyone know of a way to do this? Any help would be greatly appreciated.
