> I try to create a structure of a structure :

```
> fr_1 = { STRUCT_1_NAME, $  
>     Test_1:bytarr(12), $  
>     Test_2:bytarr(12), $  
>     Test_3:bytarr(12) $  
> }
```

```
> fr_2 = { STRUCT_2_NAME, $  
>     Test_a:bytarr(12), $  
>     Test_b:bytarr(12), $  
>     Test_c:bytarr(12) $  
> }
```

```
> fr = { STRUCT_NAME, $  
>     struct_var_2 : {STRUCT_1_NAME}, $  
>     struct_var_2 : {STRUCT_2_NAME}, $  
> }
```

> This is not working !!!!
> How can I create a structure of a structure ???
> Stephan

Your problem is extremely simple. You have a couple of simple typos in the final command. (It happens to the best of us.) If you instead enter in

```
fr = { STRUCT_NAME, $  
     struct_var_1 : {STRUCT_1_NAME}, $  
     struct_var_2 : {STRUCT_2_NAME} $  
 }
```

it should work fine.
