Hi all.

I just finished work on a new version (2.00 beta) of my EXPLORE widget based data analysis tool. You can find all about it in the updated documentation

Major changes are the inclusion of a GROUP feature and a "link" to IDL routines outside explore via EXECUTE (real nifty!)

My tools library has also been updated: the most important changes affect MYCT.PRO which now includes a RANGE feature which does sort of the opposite of the STRETCH command: it interpolates color tables. And the OPEN DEVICE, CLOSE DEVICE pair should now work on any platform, not only Unix.

Unfortunately (?) my "programming groove" must come to ends for now, because the pile of scientific papers on my desk almost prevents me from looking out of my window;-) Yet, I explicitly encourage your feedback, especially on the new EXPLORE tool.
