For example, is there a syntax like: >> >> unixprompt> idl batchprog.pro inputfile.txt >> or >> >> unixprompt> idl batchprog.pro 5 3.78 "John Doe" 24.0 I implemented such a scheme by creating a unix shell which sets up various parameters before running idl. The unix shell writes into a file which is executed by IDL by means of the "setenv IDL STARTUP ..." scheme. The shell passes along arguments from the command line, which may contain IDL commands.
