Try this:

IDL> spawn,'ps | grep idl | grep -v grep',result,/sh

IDL> print,result

23847 pd S 0:02 /usr/local/rsi/idl_4/bin/bin.sunos.4.1/idl

IDL> print,long(result)

23847

If you really feel lucky you can try something like.....

IDL> ; check your libc version before doing this!

IDL> result=call_external('/lib/libc.so.1.9','getpid')

IDL> print,result

23847
