- > By chance I have seen if I move an other window like idlde it erases the
- > wrong "colors".

I don't understand this problem. Does this machine have a 24-bit graphics card?

> The better way will be to use the backingstore directly.

Set the RETAIN flag to 2 either on the window used for the contour plot:

IDL> Window, Retain=2

Or, for all windows:

IDL> Device, Retain=2

This causes IDL to take control of the backing store. You can also do it yourself with a pixmap and the Device Copy technique if you wish, although this is more easily done in a draw widget window.
