> How do I make it so that spawn spawns to any dir I want?

I would try changing the working IDL directory to the
directory you want to use before issuing the Spawn command:

```
CD, Current=thisDirectory
CD, './myapps/data'
Spawn, 'myprograms'
CD, thisDirectory
```
