Hi, I am using idl quite a while but do not understand its behaviour under Win NT:

- 1. If I have a window created, e.g. implicitly by TVSCL I cannot change the LUT neither by LOADCT nor TVLCT? I have a truecolor video card FIRE anything set to 256 colors.
- 2. To break a long running program I am used to use GET KBRD(1) and looking for 'q' or something. Under NT the program responds (breaks) quite arbitrarily. May be this is dependent on input focus which is also during a running program very difficult to switch?

Is there anybody with some recommendations or similar experiences?
