IDL> set_plot, 'ps'
IDL> device, xsize=5 , ysize=4, /inches
    For my 640 x 512 window
IDL> plot, findgen(10)
IDL> set_plot, 'x'
IDL> plot, findgen(10)
IDL> annotate
Color=    0
    I chose, write PostScript -> Objects only
    Saved to 'idl.ps', the file opened by default above
    Then exited annotate widget
IDL> set_plot, 'ps'
IDL> device, /close
```
