> TV, image, 0.7, 0.33, /Normal, XSize=1, YSize=1
```

And I should have written this:

```
Set_Plot, 'PS'  
Device, XSize=5, YSize=3, /Inches, /Encap  
TV, image, 0.1, 0.33, /Normal, XSize=0.25, YSize=0.25  
TV, image, 0.4, 0.33, /Normal, XSize=0.25, YSize=0.25  
TV, image, 0.7, 0.33, /Normal, XSize=0.25, YSize=0.25
```
