How do I produce color postscript from Object graphics? I am doing something like this:

> sState.myprinter->Draw,sState.oView sState.myprinter->newdocument

I did a myprinter->GetProperty for color\_model, and it returns 0 (RGB) default. It should then produce PS that has the same colors as the Screen output right?

I get a nicely shaded grayscale postscript, not color output.

I downloaded David Fanning's xplot.pro, and produced B&W postscript from that (although it did do Jpeg & gif color)

Any help would be appreciated.
