Just wanted the group to know we figured out the problem I was having opening IDL files from Windows NT Explorer. When I double-click on a *.pro file in Windows Explorer a new session of IDL comes up, and I get an error message which says Windows NT can not find the file or a component and that I need to check the path name and make sure all required libraries are available. This was due to the fact that IDL is installed in the directory C:\Program Files\ RSI rather than C:\RSI We have reinstalled IDI in C:\RSI, and opening files works fine. Could anyone explain why this would be the case? Is this a bug? My System Administrator is unhappy that he can't put IDL in the Program Files directory so I told him I'd ask on the newsgroup about it. Any thoughts?
