I agree fully that WIDED is a horrific piece of (legacy?) code. But that isn't true of interactive GUI creation tools in general. Programmers on the Windows and Mac platforms have enjoyed easy-to-use visual design tools for many years.

IDL users on the other hand, while they have a nice cross-platform widget library, are stuck "doing it by hand". (Note, as IDL becomes increasingly easy to integrate with other software on the Windows platform via ActiveX, etc., this becomes more and more an issue of unix users being marginalized.)

My feeling is that RSI should rewrite WIDED from the ground up and release a widget builder worthy of a great product - IDL 5.1.
