Hello, IDL users -

In IDL version 1, I had worked out a Hershey character string to show the Angstrom symbol:

angstrom = '!S!U! !M%!RA!N'

This uses the positioning command for a half-space, '! ', which does not exist in IDL 2.x and higher versions. We are currently using IDL 2.4.0, and so cannot access the ISO Latin ASCII character set. Has anyone worked out the Hershey string for the Angstrom symbol under IDL 2.x?
