> files and directories in the selection dialog. Since the files I am using  
> pickfile to select are deep down the directory tree, idl truncates the path  
> and displays only the start of it in the selection dialog. This makes it  
> impossible for the user to know what he is selecting, unless the window is  
> resized. Is there anyway to stop idl from displaying the full path in the  
> selection box? On idl 4.3, running on a dec alpha, it does not print the  
> full path, but the path is displayed in a separate path field. Any help  
> would be greatly appreciated! -Jay Cable
