

Subject: Q: WIDGET TABLE does not fill all available space

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Hello,

I am using a `WIDGET_TABLE` to show values of a 3x3 integer matrix. It works but I get an extra frame around the table, like this:

1	2	3	
3	3	1	
1	2	2	

The relevant portion of the code is:

```
w5= widget_base(w4, /COLUMN, column=1) ; I created a widget base
wmep=widget_label(w5, uvalue="ptext") ; I add a few things in it
```

; finally I create the table
```

wtbl=widget_table(w5, ROW_LABELS=['X','Y','Z'], xsize=3,ysize=3, $
column_labels=['R','G','B'],uvalue="ctable",value=fix(cursvox), $
format='(I3)',alignment=2)
```
