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Greetings. I'm new to this news group and IDL programming so hopefully I won't bore you all with bone-headed questions (I know you do too).

I'm trying to update an old MRI image analysis program that was written for pre-5.0 IDL. I'd like to use object graphics as much as possible, but can't figure out if there is a way to select ROI's of an image object. Data picking will give me one point, but I need the ability to select polygon, square, and circle ROI's of an image. The CW_DEFROI and DEFROI procedures don't like the draw widget since it seems to be treated as an object itself (with the graphics_level set to 2).

Any thoughts or do I just need to grin and bear it and create a regular draw widget for my ROI selection?
