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Hi,

I am experimenting with using objects in IDL 5.0, and have encountered a little problem. I defined a new object (call it myobj), and also wrote a method called 'plot'. When I call myobj->plot, IDL dumps core and crashes. But when I explicitly compile the myobj__plot.pro file before calling the method, it runs just fine. Is IDL trying to run the wrong program? I thought that regular procedures and object methods don't share the name space, but are there still limitations that prohibit the use of common names like 'plot'?

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
