A couple of comments:

A linked list just cries out to be implemented as an object class. I wrote such a thing some time ago but will not post the code here for fear of ridicule.

Robert Mallozzi (Robert.Mallozzi@msfc.nasa.gov) has written some container classes, including a last-in-first-out stack and a first-in-first-out queue. The queue is useful when reading data from text files, to avoid the performance hit when extending arrays, as discussed here a week or two ago.
