map\_set, 37, -73, /mercator, /hires, /grid, limit = [34, -77, 40,-71],\$
label = 2

2:

map\_set, 37, -73, /mercator, /hires, /grid, limit = [35, -75, 39, -71],\$
label = 2

What are the limitations of the mercator projections?
