I wasn't able to solve Doug's problem. I found the Uvalue error but could not understand why the Widget ID was not valid, when, every time I printed it it had a number that matched the event.top.

That's because I was looking in the wrong place! As David Fanning astutely pointed out, the error was in the SET command at the bottom of the program, FAR away from where I thought it was.

The message from XMANAGER states simply: % XMANAGER: Caught unexpected error from client application. Message follows... % WIDGET_CONTROL: Invalid widget identifier: 61.

There are widget controls all over the code, is there any way for XMANAGER to be a little more helpful about identifying, WHICH widget_control was causing the error?
