- > mode, colors come up as shades of red rather than the proper shades unless
- > you've properly set the decomposed option. I don't recall the exact setting,
- > but that might help.

Yes. As it happens Todd was running a new version of IDL (IDL 5.1) in a 24-bit Windows environment. A simple:

Device, Decomposed=0

sorted him out.
