- > the GUI-builder on Unix systems? I'm a bit pissed that we have to
- > pay higher prices for licenses, and then are "overlooked" like
- > this. That's not what I call support.

I haven't heard of any plans for a GUI-builder on anything but Windows platforms, but RSI doesn't usually share this kind of information with me as a rule. You should ask them.

If you would be interested in trying an Application-builder (that is, a builder that not only allowed you to build the GUI interface, but also allowed you to write IDL code either in the builder or in IDL, etc.) on a UNIX platform, let me know. I may be able to help you out. What I have in mind wouldn't be free, unfortunately, but it *would* run on Windows and UNIX machines. :-)
