It's hard to make a diagnostics without the lines that failed. However, I assume that you tried the FOR-loop in the interactive mode and did not take into account that this works only on one line and that you have to combine multiple statements with the "\$" and/or "&" characters.

One simple example:

for i=0,10 do begin & print,i & j=i^2 & print,j & endfor
