Yeah, you're right it turns from an hourglass to a pointer after the loop is finished, but what happens after you select 'Yes' at the dialog_message box, click on the plot and then move your cursor to the widget? I tried this on Windows 95 and Windows NT machines here, and both times the cursor changed back to an hourglass when the cursor moved over the widget, which prevented the 'SUBMIT' button from working. However, if you select 'No' at the dialog_message box and then move to the widget, the cursor remains an arrow and the 'SUBMIT' button works. Weird.
