Is there a way to do true error handling in IDL. I've read about the ON_ERROR and MESSAGE procedures in the manuals, but the information given isn't much help.

Given two procedures A and B. If A calls B and somewhere in the execution of B an error is triggered, is there a way to truly "handle" that error. ie. can procedure A regain control, recognize that an error has occurred in B, and do something to handle the error, without halting the entire program.
