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Greetings all,

I'm just converting an old widget program from PV~Wave to IDL: it's pretty much a re-write with rather better functionality, but for various reasons it needs to be done by, oh, yesterday, so some help would be much appreciated!

The program is to define ROIs in sequential slices of a stack MRI brain images, so the basis is a CW_ZOOM to allow the user to identify the bit they're interested in and then zoom in to make the definition easier. Now the bit I can't work out, which is getting the widget ID of the draw window that CW_ZOOM's using for the display, so I can pass that into CW_DEFROI.

Any suggestions as to how this is done, or alternative strategies to get the ROI set on a CW_ZOOM widget window?
