I think you may have to give up on !P.Multi in this case, unless you are really, really clever (and even then I'm not sure you could do it or that it would be worth the effort). I think it would be much easier to just position the plots in the window yourself. Subsequent plots can be drawn into the window with the NOErase keyword.
