I observe that CATCH doesn't capture type conversion errors (in the absence of ON_IOERROR command). This appears to violate the error handling mechanism given in the IDL user's guide. Am I missing something? Are there any other errors which CATCH can not capture?

PRO test
CATCH, err
IF ( err NE 0 ) THEN BEGIN
  PRINT, !ERROR
  RETURN
ENDIF
a = FIX ( 'abc' )

END
```
