> ... but be careful to use parantheses when you want to clamp min and  
> max at the same time:  
>   twoodle_array = (twoodle_array < max_val ) > min_val
```

In that case I don't use parantheses either, because I think the following "looks" nicer: ;-)

```
twoodle_array = min_val > twoodle_array < max_val
```
