When emulating a UNIX environment on a Pentium with Windows 95 using Version 3.4.1 of XWIN-32 from StarNet Communications Corp, many of the interactive IDL graphics such as 'idlde' cause a conflict such that the IDL window freezes. Typing demo at the idl prompt causes the same problem, resulting in a flat grey window that no longer responds to key presses. Other IDL functions work fine, such as plotting and using the interactive help environment. print, !d.n_colors responds 235 colors, so I don't think it is being limited by the number of colors. Does anyone have any ideas or suggestions?
