> When emulating a UNIX environment on a Pentium with Windows 95 using
> Version 3.4.1 of XWIN-32 from StarNet Communications Corp, many of the
> interactive IDL graphics such as 'idlde' cause a conflict such that the
> IDL window freezes. Typing demo at the idl prompt causes the same
> problem, resulting in a flat grey window that no longer responds to key
> presses. Other IDL functions work fine, such as plotting and using the
> interactive help environment. print, !d.n_colors responds 235 colors,
> so I don't think it is being limited by the number of colors. Does
> anyone have any ideas or suggestions?

I'd try an upgrade of the XWIN-32 software. We use the current version
(4.1) daily with no problems.
