> 'thick' seem to quantized in integers, so that thick=1 = thick=1.5 =
> thick=1.999, but thick=2 is different?
>
> Anyone else getting these results?

That does seem to be what happens on my hardware (PC) too.
I can't recall whether it is also true for output to a printer. You
may appear to have fine control over the line thickness on a printer
because the native units (or pixels/texels) are so much smaller.
But it is probably still quantized.
