With the SUN-C-Compiler under Solaris 2.3 I use the following syntax to create a shared library archiv:

```
idlmeteo.so: $(C_SRCS)
cc -G -Kpic -c $(C_SRCS)
ld -G -o idlmeteo.so $(C_OBJS)
```

Does someone know how is the syntax for the GNU - C Compiler (gcc 2.4.5) to get a shared library archive ?
