- > If I go right up to the dateline but not over it, I get a nice map
- > including Japan:
- > map_set,/grid, /continent,limit = [0,100,50,180]

How about this:

```
map_set, 0, -180, scale=100e6, /continent, /grid, /label
```

My advice is to avoid the LIMIT keyword whenever possible.
