Try

```
anzfile=findfile(string(format='(I0,"*")',num),count=anz)
```

but only if num is an integer. If you really want num to be decimal, your user must pass it in as a string, unless you just happen to know you **always** want only one digit past the decimal, in which case you can use a floating format. This is more error prone and dangerous, however.
