It now honors the !P.Multi system variable if the MULTI
keyword is set.

!P.Multi=[0, 3, 2]
TVImage, image, /Multi
TVImage, image, /Multi, /Keep_Aspect
TVImage, image, /Multi, Margin=0.02
etc....
```
